

# Dino Feet

## Materials

- Two empty Kleenex boxes (For larger feet, you can use cracker or cereal boxes.)
- Craft foam
- Scissors
- Glue gun or white glue

## Procedure

**Step 1:** If the opening on the top of the box is too small for a child's foot to fit through, make the opening larger.



**Step 2:** Cut out two dinosaur footprints from craft foam (the footprints should be larger than the boxes) and make two 12-13 cm (5 in) criss-crossed snips in the centre of each foot print.

**Step 3:** Using a glue gun (white glue can also be used but it does not hold as well), attach one footprint to each Kleenex box so that the cuts in the foam are directly over the opening on the box.

**Step 4:** Glue on foam claws to the toes of each foot and any other decorations such as polka dots, stripes, etc.



**Step 5:** When the glue has dried, the feet can be put on like slippers and used in a number of ways, such as dinosaur musical chairs or dinosaur relays. Just use your imagination.
