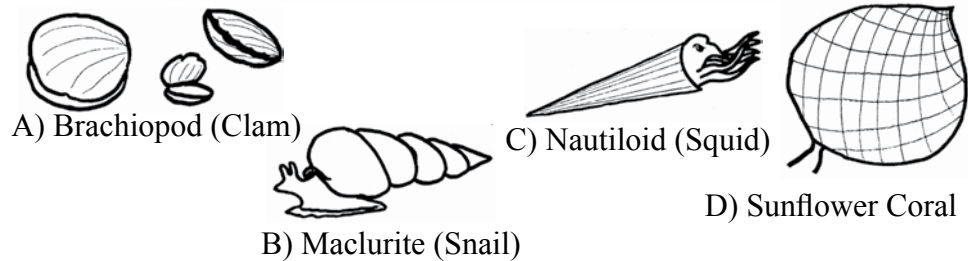
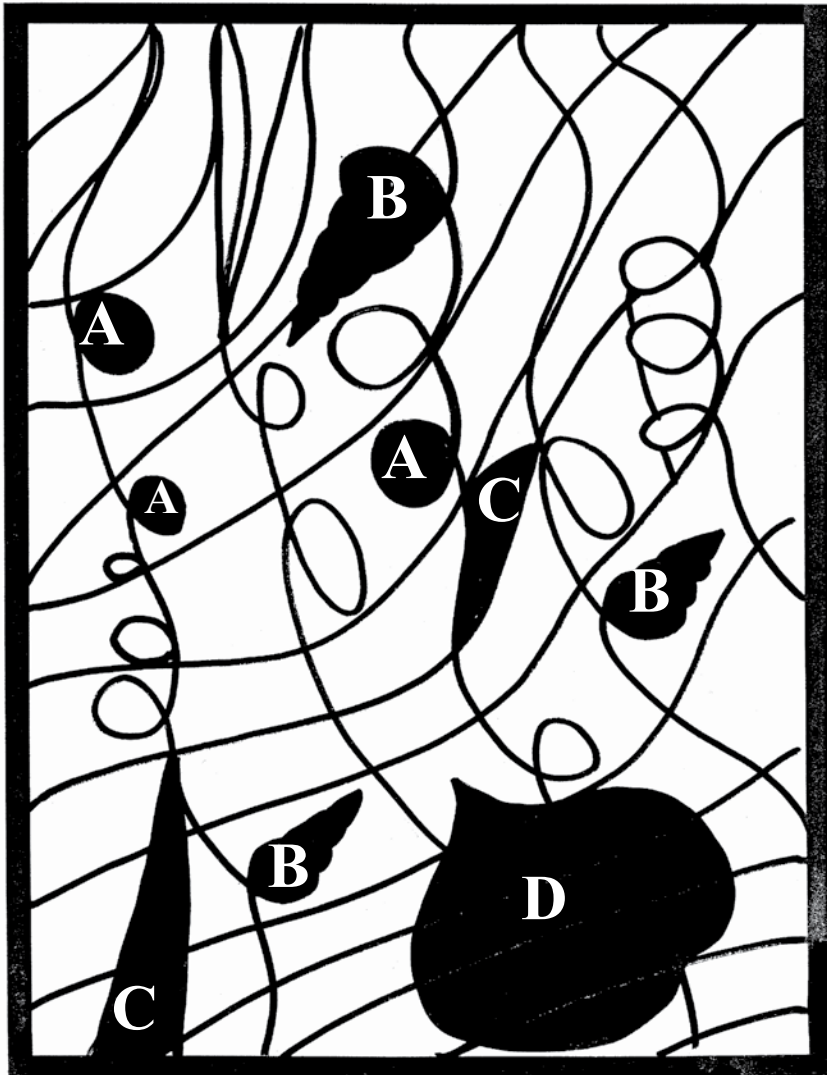

The temperature of the earth's core is estimated to be about 7000°C.

Over 99% of the earth's species that have ever lived have gone extinct.



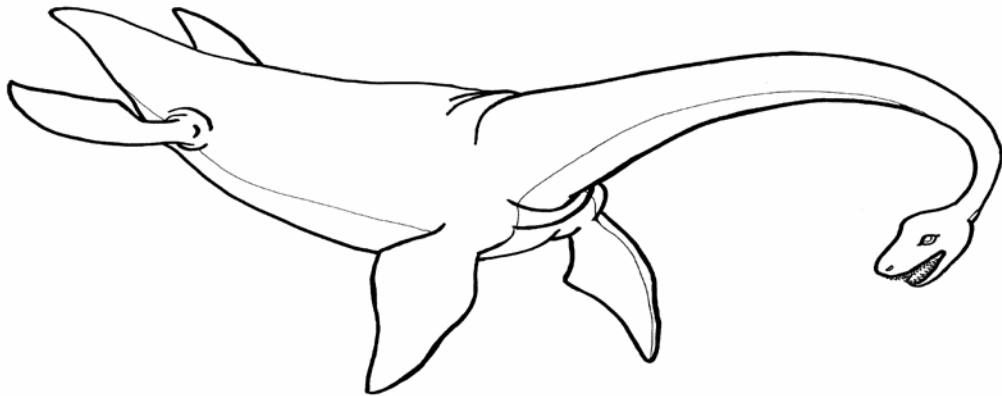
