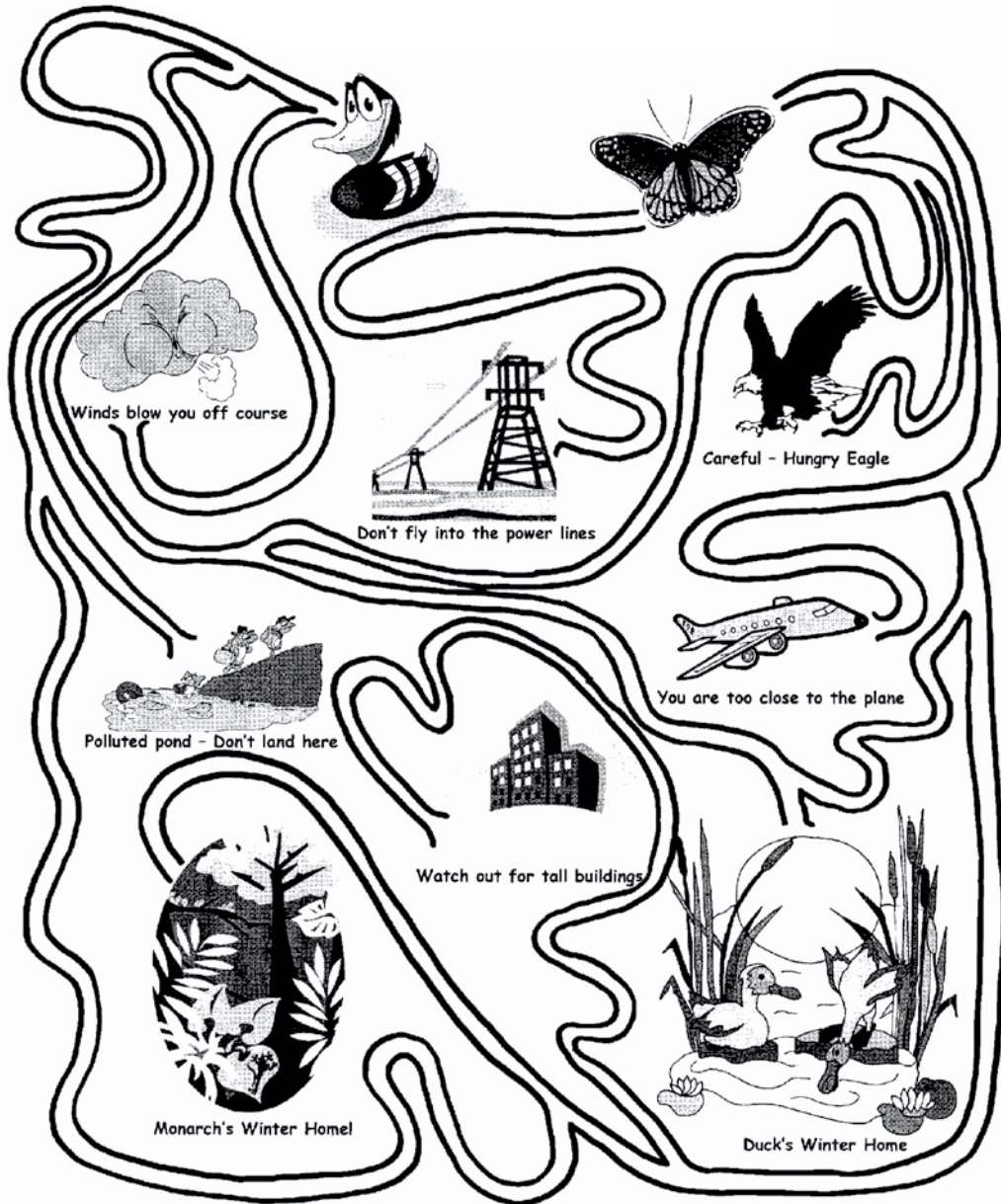


# MIGRATION MAZE

### ANSWER GUIDE

All the leaves in the Bur Oak diorama are real. They were soaked in a preserving solution, painted, then individually glued back on to the trees, which are also real.

1) What animal is hiding under the Black Spruce tree behind the Moose? **Snowshoe Hare** (This is the first diorama you see when you enter the Gallery.)

2) At the *Bogs, Fens, and Muskegs* display, get down on your hands and knees. How many beetles do you see? **One, the Predaceous Diving Beetle** (This is a small display across from the Moose diorama.)

3) How many black wolves are in this display?

**Two**

(The second black wolf is in the background painting.)

4) What frightening sound do you hear when the lights go out in the *Mixed Woods*? **Cougar roar** (You might have to wait a while for the lights to go out to hear the Cougar.)

5) Standing in front of the *Aspen Parkland* display, jump up and down. What animal in the display are you pretending to be? **White-tailed Jack Rabbit** (This display is a winter diorama containing White-tailed Deer. The Jack Rabbit is near the front.)

6) Draw what is missing in this display:



7) In the *Mixed Grassland* display, what animal dug the burrow in the ground? **American Badger** (This display contains the Pronghorn; the burrow is found on the right side of the diorama.)

8) What season is it in the *Cypress Hills* display? **Fall** (Have the kids look at the colour of the leaves in the background painting.)

9) What colours do you see on the Toucan in the rainforest display? **Yellow, red, black, and white** (The Toucan is found on a lower branch near the front.)

10) List or draw three kinds of tracks you see in the Time Tunnel. **Bicycle tracks, human footprints, animal tracks, tire tracks.**

11) The photograph of the earth is taken from what object in space? **The moon** (This is the picture that can be seen at the end of the "Time Tunnel".)
